GENERAL INFORMATION

Pre-Entries Due May 22, 2023

Fees

- Class Fees: Youth \$10/class, All Others \$25/class
- Performance Championship Class Fee: \$25/class
- Office Fee: \$25/horse (not per horse/exhibitor combination)
- Stall/Tack Fee: \$95/Stall (Friday-Sunday)
- Shavings: \$9 (No outside shavings allowed)
- Early arrival/ Late Departure: \$30/day/stall
- Late Entry Fee: \$35 plus regular fees (if entering after closing date on May 22, 2023)
- GHSA membership (at least one of the horse's owners must be a member)
 - Annual Adult \$20
 - Annual Youth \$10
 - Annual Family \$50
 - Lifetime \$500
 - Non-Member \$10/horse (This is for insurance purposes)

Please note that you must be a GHSA member prior to competing in your first GHSA competition of 2023 to be eligible for the Belt Buckle Series (When a youth or amateur is showing, they will enter the program in the month their membership is paid, and the amateur declaration is received. Points will not be retroactive.).

Awards

- Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place in all classes.
- Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes.
- All Lead Line participants will receive a ribbon.

All fees must be paid, and correct information provided before the show office releases exhibitor/horse number. Cash, check, or credit card accepted. An open check is required if adding classes during the show.

Refunds

Cancellations prior to the closing date will be refunded minus the office fees. No refunds on scratched classes for any reason.

Out-of-State Horse

All horses competing from outside the state of Texas are required to provide a current Coggins test within the last 12 months of the horse show along with a current health certificate.

Non-Showing Horses

Horses NOT competing are allowed on the grounds if space is available. The owner must fill out an entry form and pay the office and stall fees. Coggins and a health certificate (out of state horses) are required.

Rule Book

All owners, trainers or competitors are required to read the Gypsy Horse Show Association Rule Book prior to the show. The rule book is located within the “file” section at:

Camping

All camp sites are supplied with electric, water and sewer hook-ups.

Entry Notes

At least one owner of the full-bred Gypsy Vanner/Gypsy Horse to be shown must be a paid member of the Gypsy Horse Show Association. Otherwise, a non-member fee of \$10 per horse will be assessed at each show.

Current registration papers verifying current gender, age and ownership must be submitted with entries. For horses being leased or purchased on a payment plan, please include a copy of the lease or contract.

No cross entering between Gypsy and/or Gypsy-cross classes unless otherwise noted.

Liability waivers must be completed with all requested names/signatures.

Horses cannot compete in any driving or riding classes until they are 3 years old.

Horses age is as of January 1st.

Hospitality

Concessions will be available on-site Saturday and Sunday.

Buy A Class

\$30/class plus normal entry fee (\$10 youth or \$25 all others)

Stabling

Stalls are 12x10 with gate on dirt floors. Fee is \$95 (Friday-Sunday). Stall fee does NOT include shavings. You may purchase from the facility for \$9/bag or bring your own. If ordered in advance, the shavings will be in your stalls upon arrival.

Tack Stalls are the same price as horse stalls. On the entry form, list the total number of stalls you will need.

Availability: Friday at 8 am until Sunday at 11:59 pm. Early arrival on Thursday at 12 pm/noon and/or late departure on Monday morning is available for \$30/day/stall.

Please make a note if you want to be stalled with a certain group/barn/trainer/farm.

Accommodations

There are local hotel accommodations in the area if not camping on site. Any special show rates will be announced on social media and organization website as it becomes available.

Dogs

Well-mannered dogs are allowed on the grounds but **MUST ALWAYS** be leashed.

Competition Rules

1. The same horse/rider combination cannot cross enter into both Walk/Jog or Walk/Trot classes and classes that require three gaits (Walk/Jog/Lope or Walk/Trot/Canter).
 - a. EXCEPTION: WJL/WTC horse may enter either the WJ/WT or WJL/WTC Trail. BUT not both.
2. Horse under saddle or in harness must not have their sight impaired by their forelock (band or braid it).
3. Please refer to the GHSA Rule Book for appropriate attire and tack for classes. If in doubt, ASK!
4. A GREEN horse is in its first year of showing.
5. Failure of and exhibitor to wear the correct number and/or in a visible manner will be given one warning before being disqualified in subsequent classes.
6. Protests, charges and grievances should be directed to the Show Manager for resolution but all decisions by the judge(s) are final.
7. Back numbers stay with the horse and will be the same throughout the competition regardless of exhibitor.
8. Riders in 9 and under classes are allowed an attendant.

Show Operations

- Show Management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry from a class due to Rule Book violations.
- Show Management reserves the right to revise start times.
- Show Management may combine or divide classes.
- Entries will not be allowed into the show arena without the correct back number.
- The class list provided is in chronological order and is the actual class order.
- Make sure that you only enter classes you and/or your horse are eligible to show. Refunds will not be given for entering an incorrect class.
- Lunch, set up, tear down and preparation breaks are at the discretion of the Judge and Show Management.
- Hazardous weather, Acts of God, Accident Policy: Show Management reserves the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies. Every effort will be made to reschedule due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents, or emergencies.
- Show Management reserves the right to change officials, limit entries, combine or cancel classes and modify the schedule as required.
